## **REVISED AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARD/AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION STANDARD NO. 89 FOR DENTAL OPERATING LIGHTS**

The ADA Standards Committee on Dental Products (SCDP) has approved Revised ANSI/ADA Standard No. 89 for Dental Operating Lights. This and other standards for dental materials, instruments and equipment are being formulated by working groups of the ADA SCDP. The Committee has representation from all interests in the United States in the standardization of materials, instruments and equipment in dentistry. The Committee has adopted the standards, showing professional recognition of their usefulness in dentistry, and has forwarded them to the American National Standards Institute with a recommendation that the standards be approved as American National Standards. The American National Standards Institute granted approval of ADA Standard No. 89 as an American National Standard on December 21, 2017.

This standard is an identical adoption of ISO 9680:2014, Dentistry – Operating Lights. ADA SCDP Working Group 6.37 Dental Operatory Lights examined the international standard and found it acceptable for identical adoption as revised ANSI/ADA Standard No. 89.

The proposed revision of ANSI/ADA Standard No. 89 for Dental Operating Lights cancels and replaces ANSI/ADA Standard No. 89:2008 (R2013), which was an identical adoption of ISO 9680:2007.
