Foreword

This Published Document has been prepared by Technical Committee EPL/92, Safety of audio, video and similar electronic equipment.

This Published Document consists of the identical text to IEC committee document 92/82/INF, which was compiled using the results of a request from IEC/TC 92, circulated as 92/80/INF, for questions on interpretation related to IEC 60065:1998 (sixth edition). Document 92/80/INF contained the following text:

"Questions on the interpretation of IEC 60065, mostly raised by manufacturers and test agencies, were not previously dealt with in a structured way. In most cases, these interpretation matters were discussed in IEC TC 92/WG1 during the WG meetings, in order to obtain a common opinion. These common opinions from experienced members of the TC 92 working group are considered to be of interest to all users of the standard. For that reason, IEC/TC 92 management has decided to publish important opinions in a commonly available document. It is to be noted that:

- the opinions given in these documents do not replace the text in IEC 60065,
- if a question shows that there is a lack of clarity, or requirements are missing, a remedy will be considered during the maintenance activities on IEC 60065."

BS EN 60065:1998 is the European standard derived from IEC 60065:1998 (sixth edition). None of the subclauses referred to were modified in CENELEC.
